Re: SB 348, accident “taxes” ban

Dear Governor Perdue:

As you know, SB 348 is on its way to you, and with your signature on it, Georgia will join the vanguard of states taking action to ensure citizens are not subject to double taxation for core government services.


I am with the National Association of Mutual Insurance Companies. NAMIC is a trade association representing more than 1,400 member companies underwriting 40 percent of the property/casualty insurance premium in the United States and ranging in size from one-county farm mutuals to companies doing business throughout the country. In Georgia, we have 160 members that collectively write 42% percent of the auto insurance market.

Insurance industry representatives and city/county government representatives worked together to ensure appropriate language in the bill. SB 348 sends a message that all of Georgia is open for business and its cities and towns welcome visitors and provide critical services for all.

On behalf of our members and their policyholders, I urge you to sign SB 348 as soon as possible.
