AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 20-264, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE COVERAGE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

Section 1. Section 20-264, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

20-264. Automobile insurance; damaged safety equipment deductible optional; definition

A. Any insurer writing private passenger automobile insurance ~~which~~ THAT includes comprehensive coverage for motor vehicle damage ~~shall provide~~ MAY OFFER COVERAGE THAT PROVIDES at the option of the insured complete coverage for the repair or replacement of all damaged safety equipment without regard to any deductible.

B. ~~As used in~~ FOR THE PURPOSES OF this section, "safety equipment" means the glass used in the windshield, doors and windows and the glass, plastic or other material used in the lights of a motor vehicle.
