Litigation Harvesting Unleashed

This session will examine the growing practice of "litigation harvesting," in which legal claims are mass-generated through aggressive marketing campaigns, third-party intake vendors, lead generators, contractor networks, and outside financial backing following catastrophic events. It will explore the ethical, legal, and regulatory concerns associated with high-volume claim acquisition models, including issues involving client solicitation, attorney-client relationship formation, litigation financing, and claims management practices. Using a detailed hurricane-related insurance litigation case study, the session will analyze how these coordinated systems can drive large-scale insurance litigation and increase exposure to regulatory scrutiny, disciplinary actions, financial abuse, and operational risks affecting insurers, policyholders, and the legal profession.
